Rheta Reagan, Mayor, called the regular meeting of the Edgemont Common Council to order at 7:00 p.m. on April 7, 2026, at Edgemont City Hall. Present were Council members Kathryn Fiscus, Junior Harper, David Levey, Jarell Rola, Dennis Tubb and Brent White.

### **TEMPORARY MALT BEVERAGE/LIQUOR LICENSE**

Kevin Moran, Victory Steakhouse, met with the board. Brent White made a motion to approve a temporary malt beverage/liquor license for the Victory Steakhouse annual car show, contingent upon road closure from the state. Motion was seconded by Kathryn Fiscus. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

### **POSSIBLE CITY PROPERTY PURCHASE**

Patty Schultz, representing Steve Kessenich, met with the board. Brent White made a motion to table the possible purchase of the city property near the airport until the next meeting so further research could be done on what the FAA will allow. Motion was seconded by Dennis Tubb.

### **SHEDCO UPDATES**

Andrea Powers, SHEDCO, met with board. Discussion was held on grants that she had been working on. Grants include a windnet grant for the pickleball court, a catapult imitative grant, a local mobile app, an outdoor gym grant and several different types of grants to assist with remodeling or building homes.

### **UTILITY DEPARTMENT HIRING**

Dennis Tubb made a motion to approve hiring Aaron Lauseng full time to fill the vacant position for the utility department at \$16.00 per hour, effective April 22, 2026. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.
