CALL TO ORDER - ROLL CALL

Mayor Rheta Reagan, called the regular meeting of the Edmonton Common Council to order at 7:00 p.m. on August 5, 2025 at Edmonton City Hall. Present were Council members Kathryn Fiscus, Junior Harper, Jarrell Rola, Dennis Tubb and Brent White. David Levey was absent

Kathryn Fiscus made a motion to approve the low bid from Nelson's at \$1.79 per gallon, with a prebuy contract. Motion was seconded by Junior Harper. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

FUEL BIDS

Fuel bids were opened and read as follows:

Dennis Tubb made a motion to accept the fuel bid from Stern at \$3.31 per gallon for gasoline and \$3.52 per gallon for diesel. Motion was seconded by Brent White. With Fiscus and Harper voting no, Tubb and White voting yes and Rola abstaining, motion failed.

FALL FESTIVAL

Jarrell Rola made a motion to approve the Edgemont Chamber of Commerce to hold the 2025 Fall Festival/Car Show on September 27, 2025. Motion was seconded by Brent White. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

CHANCE LESLIE ENGLEBERT MEMORIAL DERBY

Brent White made a motion to allow a temporary malt beverage license at the 2025 Chance Leslie Englebert Memorial Derby, on September 27, 2025, at the fairgrounds. Motion was seconded by Kathryn Fiscus. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

STREET DANCE

Jarrell Rola made a motion to approve the temporary malt beverage and liquor license for the Victory Steakhouse and Lounge to hold a street dance on September 27, 2025 contingent on approval from the state that will allow the highway closure. Motion was seconded by Kathryn Fiscus. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

BUILDING PERMITS/VARIANCE

Brent White made a motion to approve the variance for Myron Cleveland to remove the sidewalk near his house. Motion was seconded by Dennis Tubb. With Tubb voting no, all others voting yes, motion carries.

Jarrell Rola made a motion to approve the building permit for Gary Kester to build a shop/garage on his lot. Motion was seconded by Dennis Tubb. With Tubb voting no, all others voting yes, motion carried.

Brent White made a motion to approve the building permit for Mark Waterman to approve building a home on his lot, with the contingency that the projected cost of building would be \$75,000.00. Motion was seconded by Dennis Tubb. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Dennis Tubb made a motion to approve the building permit for Sean Page to build a pole barn on his lot. Motion was seconded by Jarrell Rola. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Brent White made a motion to approve the building permit for Michelle Snapp on her property. Motion was seconded by Jarrell Rola. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

CEMETERY BOARD

Jarrell Rola made a motion to remove Dallas Stewart from the cemetery board and add Connie Gerard to replace him. Motion was seconded by Brent White. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

ELECTED OFFICIALS WORKSHOP

Brent White made a motion to not send anyone to the elected officials' workshop in Pierre in October 2025. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

ADJOURNMENT

Dennis Tubb made a motion to adjourn at 7:58 p.m. Motion was seconded by Jarrell Rola. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
